How are you coming along with your Half Square Triangle Challenge project? Not started yet? Hate to think of making a lot of HST's? Don't forget that there are short cuts you can use when you need a LOT of HST's.

Ledine at Sugar Stitches Quilt Company has designed a great chart for your HST's. Including how to make 8 and 32 at a time! I am doing 8 at a time for my project and it is going very fast.

Please note that your HST's will need to be trimmed to their precise measurement. The "unfinished trim size" in the first column is the size you will be trimming the HST to. This will then give you a finished HST of $\frac{1}{2}$ " smaller. For example, I want my HST's to finish at 4 inches on the finished quilt. I will be trimming to 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ ". To make 8 at a time, I will start with 2 squares that measure 11 inches.
